Judicial and Staff Moves

Please note the following:

Judge Thompson and her staff are temporarily in courtroom 303C. You may contact Judge Thompson's staff at 503.846.3617 during this time. Judge Thompson and her staff will likely be located there through approximately December 26. They will return to 202C after that time.

Judge Nachtigal and her staff will be leaving 440J and will relocate to the Law Enforcement Center (LEC1) beginning in December 31, through her anticipated retirement in July 2013. One judge and staff will be relocated to 440J after Judge Nachtigal's relocation. Further information, new extensions and contact information will be provided once it has been finalized.

Diversion Early Case Resolution (DECR) Docket
