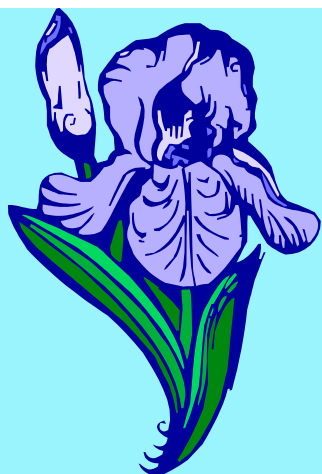
Finally, family law judges will address the Current Practice of Family Law in Washington County.

LEGAL RESEARCH PRACTICE TIPS

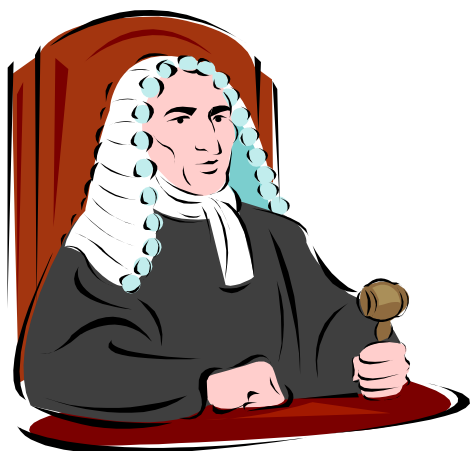
We've been renegotiating our Law Library Westlaw and Lexis contracts and the good news is:
